Class Participation (5%) Class Participation is **REQUIRED** for this course. Students will receive a weekly grade of 100 for attending and participating in class. If you are caught texting, doing work for another class, sleeping, or otherwise off task, points will be deducted from your class participation grade.

Homework (10%) All homework assignments will be assigned in Delta Math (teacher code 507918) or Florida Virtual (accessed through clever). Please be advised you are required to complete the assignment on Delta Math or Florida Virtual, as well as, turn in (upload) shown work for the assignment. Failure to upload work shown will result in a grade of zero.

Classwork, Quizzes and Bell Work (35%) All Classwork must be completed and submitted before the end of class. Bell Work should be completed and submitted within the first FIVE minutes of class.

Assessments (40%)

Students will take regular assessments to gauge mastery. Tests will be completed on the appropriate platform and shown work must be submitted. Failure to upload work will result in a zero.

Projects (10%)

There will be at least one project assigned each quarter.

Make-Up Policy

Students are expected to begin make up work immediately upon returning to school. A ZERO will be given for work that hasn't met the following guidelines:

~ *Homework/Classwork/Projects*

One day of make-up time shall be allowed for each day of unexcused absence. For example, if a student is absent two days, they will be given two days to make up missing assignments.

~ *Assessments*

Students will have seven school days to make-up assessments. Assessments can **ONLY** be made up during PM.class periods.

Extended Time

In some cases, SPED/504/ESL students will receive extended time as allowed by their plans. This will occur during PM class periods ONLY. All weekly assignments will be due Sundays at 10:00 pm.
